

Dear Commissioner,

Thank you for the opportunity to provide a suggestion on the boundary review of WA's 59 electoral districts and six electoral regions. My suggestions are divided by region and are provided in detail commencing the following page.

In summary, it is suggested that:

1. The District of Eyre be abolished
2. The District of Serpentine-Jarrahdale be created and located in the South West Region
3. The three metropolitan regions continue to contain an equal number of districts
4. Due to suggested boundary changes; Wagin be renamed Katanning, Swan Hills be renamed Swan Valley, West Swan be renamed Ballajura and Ocean Reef be renamed Mindarie
5. The Mining and Pastoral region loses the Shires of Esperance and Ravensthorpe to the Agricultural Region and gains the Shire of Northampton from the Agricultural Region
6. Albany district be transferred to the Agricultural Region
7. North Metropolitan region lose electors to the East Metropolitan region
8. The East Metropolitan and South Metropolitan regions lose electors to the South West Region; as well as exchanging some electors between the two regions
9. 17 districts stay unchanged, including the majority of the South West Region

### Mining and Pastoral Region

It is proposed that the district of Eyre be abolished with the northern part being transferred to the district of Kalgoorlie and the southern part being transferred to the Agricultural Region. To bring Kalgoorlie within quota, the northern Goldfields shires of Leonora and Ngaanyatjarraku can be transferred to the district of North West Central.

Due to electors being transferred from Eyre to the Agricultural Region, it is proposed that the Shire of Northampton be transferred from Moore to North West Central, uniting all Shires located in the Murchison catchment. This will also allow North West Central to contain some more 'real electors' as opposed to being largely made up from the Large District Allowance. Furthermore, towns like Kalbarri have similar functions to towns further to the north such as Denham, Coral Bay and Exmouth.

The Kimberley and Pilbara districts form contiguous geographical regions and are both within quota so should stay as is. The district of Kalgoorlie will be close to 10% above the VFADE. Due to this area experiencing less than average population growth, this figure should decrease over time.

### Agricultural Region

The Agricultural Region moves south to accommodate for the transfer of the Shire of Northampton to the Mining and Pastoral Region in return for the Shires of Esperance and Ravensthorpe. It is also proposed that the Albany district be transferred from the South West Region. Albany is recognised as being part of the Great Southern geographical region – an agricultural region. Its transport network is better connected to the north and, like Geraldton, Albany acts as a service town for the farming sector. Furthermore, the majority of Albany’s boundary is to the north.

Transferring the Shire of Northampton north from Moore allows for the City of Greater Geraldton to be located entirely in the district of Geraldton, along with the Shire of Chapman Valley. The district of Moore can then move south to accommodate all shires north of the Great Eastern Highway from Central Wheatbelt. To balance Central Wheatbelt, electors north of the Shires of West Arthur, Wagin, Dumbleyung and Lake Grace can be transferred from the district of Wagin.

The Shires of Esperance and Ravensthorpe can be moved to the Wagin district to achieve the enrolment target. This district would require a small Large District Allowance. As the town of Wagin will no longer be in the centre of this district, it is proposed the district be named Katanning.

### South West Region

It is proposed that the districts that were in the previous South West Region not be altered during this redistribution as all districts are within quota. It is proposed that the boundaries of the South West Region be changed by transferring Albany to the Agricultural Region and gaining a new district to the north named SERPENTINE-JARRAHDALÉ.

The existing metropolitan regions have grown faster than the rest of the State, requiring the creation of a 43rd district. Having 43 districts in the metropolitan regions would make it impossible to achieve three metropolitan regions that are of the same size and would result in one region containing 15 districts – a difference of approximately 7-8% more than other metropolitan regions.

Despite, the Town Planning Scheme (TPS) description of the Perth metropolitan area, the definition of what is and isn't metropolitan is not necessarily clear. For example, there is little difference between the suburb of Singleton in the City of Rockingham and Madora Bay in the City of Mandurah. The same could be argued for Serpentine and Pinjarra, Wundowie and Wooroloo and Bullsbrook and Muchea – all suburb pairs that lie on the TPS metropolitan boundary. It is for this reason that it should be made acceptable to transfer the largely rural Serpentine-Jarrahdale Shire and some adjacent areas to the South West Region in order to achieve the electoral act requirements for equally sized metropolitan regions. One further argument to create a new Serpentine-Jarrahdale based seat is that this Shire is administratively located in the Peel Region, which also contains the Mandurah, Dawesville and Murray-Wellington districts.

The new district of Serpentine-Jarrahdale can reach enrolment tolerance by including Baldivis and Karnup from the City of Rockingham

### South Metropolitan Region

The transfer of Baldivis and Karnup from the South Metropolitan region brings both the districts of Kwinana and Warnbro within the 10% quota. To square off the south western boundary of the Kwinana district, the localities of East Rockingham and Hillman can be transferred from Rockingham. Directly north, the districts of Cockburn and Fremantle are above or close to 10% of the average district enrolment. Fremantle could be brought within tolerance by uniting the suburb of Hamilton Hill within the district and transferring the suburb of Palmyra to the district of Willagee. To create a more suitable boundary for Willagee, the suburb of Spearwood should then be transferred to Cockburn. Cockburn can then be brought within tolerance by losing Success and Hammond Park to Jandakot (joining Atwell and Aubin Grove) and gaining the rest of the locality of South Lake from Jandakot.

The Jandakot district can then reach its electoral quota by transferring Bibra Lake and North Lake north to Bateman. There should be minor boundary changes between Alfred Cove, Bateman and Willagee to ensure that suburbs are united in one district where possible. This includes transferring all of Melville and Myaree to Willagee and all of Booragoon to Alfred Cove. Bateman can be brought closer to the average enrolment by taking Rossmoyne from the Riverton district.

To the south of the CBD lie the districts of South Perth, Victoria Park and Belmont. It has geographically been easier to maintain acceptable enrolment figures for South Perth and Victoria Park and no change is therefore required for these districts. Belmont, located in the East Metropolitan region, has been near 10% below average enrolment since 2005. It has proven difficult to increase the size of Belmont to the east and west. This proposal recommends that Belmont be moved south to take in Queens Park and East Cannington from Cannington district.

The Cannington district itself can then move south to include Thornlie while losing Beckenham to Forrestfield and Wilson to Riverton. The flow on effect provides a solution to bringing the district of Southern River within quota. It is inevitable that Southern River would have to lose Huntingdale. The only direction that Huntingdale could go is east to Gosnells which creates a situation where Thornlie could no longer be contained within Gosnells, hence the proposal to move it north to Cannington. The adjacent suburb of Harrisdale could then be transferred to bring Southern River within the 10% tolerance.

Collectively, these changes will result in the South Metropolitan Region losing Baldivis and Karnup to the South West Region; and Huntingdale, Beckenham, East Cannington and Queens Park to the East Metropolitan Region. The South Metropolitan Region gains Thornlie and Harrisdale from the East Metropolitan Region.

### East Metropolitan Region

In this proposal, the district of Darling Range changes markedly due to the transfer of the Shire of Serpentine-Jarrahdale to the South West Region. Once Harrisdale has been transferred from Darling Range to Southern River, the localities of Piara Waters and Forrestdale would be disconnected from the remainder of the district. The solution to this is to move Armadale west to accommodate these suburbs and transfer Mt Nasura and Mt Richon to Darling Range. Darling Range can reach enrolment quotas by moving north to take in electors from the eastern part of Swan Hills district.

The district of Gosnells gains Huntingdale and loses Thornlie (detailed in South Metropolitan Region) and can then become an east-west based seat, taking in Maddington, Martin and Orange Grove from Forrestfield and Kalamunda. Forrestfield gains Beckenham from Cannington which requires Maida Vale to be transferred to Kalamunda.

Like Darling Range, Kalamunda moves north by transferring suburbs near to Darlington from Swan Hills. Nearby Midland expands to include South Guildford from Belmont. This is due to Belmont moving south to include East Cannington and Queens Park.

Due to the 'hills' part of Swan Hills being transferred to Darling Range and Kalamunda, the name of the district should be changed to Swan Valley. Swan Valley moves west to include the Ellenbrook area and localities west of the Swan River. The transfer of the locality of West Swan would mean the district of West Swan changes its name to Ballajura, after the largest suburb in the area. Ballajura district will include the remainder of the Ballajura suburb from Mirrabooka and move west to include Darch and Lansdale from Girrawheen.

Due to enrolment quotas it is not possible to transfer Caversham to Swan Valley. It can instead be moved to Bassendean, connecting new estates with nearby Beechboro and Lockridge. This would require the transfer of a small part of the suburb of Morley from Bassendean to Morley. Maylands and Mount Lawley should require no changes.

The East Metropolitan Region loses the Shire of Serpentine-Jarrahdale to the South West Region as well as the localities of Thornlie and Harrisdale to the South Metropolitan Region. This region gains Huntingdale, Beckenham, East Cannington and Queens Park from the South Metropolitan region; and Darch and Lansdale from the North Metropolitan region.

### North Metropolitan Region

The North Metropolitan Region decreases in size, losing the localities of Darch and Lansdale to the East Metropolitan Region. The district this has the greatest impact on is Girrawheen. To gain electors, Girrawheen moves west to include Greenwood and Warwick. The suburb of Hamersley can be transferred from Girrawheen to be united in the Balcatta district. This change means Kingsley would have to move west of the Mitchell Freeway to encompass the suburbs of Craigie from Joondalup district and Padbury from Hillarys district.

This change would avoid the division of the contiguous Wanneroo area that lies between Joondalup Drive and Ocean Reef Road east of Lake Joondalup. Instead Wanneroo loses only the locality of Carramar to Butler. Butler district was the largest district and with the addition of Carramar; Clarkson and Quinns Rock can move south to the new Mindarie district. It is proposed that Ocean Reef be named Mindarie due to the district moving north and shedding the suburb of Ocean Reef as well as Currambine. The district of Joondalup loses Craigie but gains the rest of Currambine and moves west to the coast by taking in the suburb of Ocean Reef north of Hodges Drive.

The district of Hillarys, like Mindarie (and the former Ocean Reef) becomes a north-south aligned coastal suburb district with Marmion Avenue as its eastern boundary from Hodges Drive to Beach Road. To the south, it is proposed that Carine, Scarborough, Churchlands and Cottesloe not be changed as they are all close to the average district enrolment. Minor boundary changes would be required between Nedlands and Perth to balance elector numbers. This includes Kings Park and parts of West Perth being transferred to Nedlands. In the past the Nedlands district boundary has extended east to the Mitchell Freeway.
